**Topic:** Alternative resident education license training

"**Sec. 3319.26.** (A) The state board of education shall adopt 4  
rules establishing the standards and requirements for obtaining an 5  
alternative resident educator license for teaching in grades 6  
kindergarten to twelve, or the equivalent, in a designated subject 7  
area or in the area of intervention specialist, as defined by rule 8  
of the state board. The rules shall also include the reasons for 9  
which an alternative resident educator license may be renewed 10  
under division (D) of this section. 11

(B) The superintendent of public instruction and the 12  
chancellor of the Ohio board of regents jointly shall develop an 13  
intensive pedagogical training institute to provide instruction in 14  
the principles and practices of teaching for individuals seeking 15  
an alternative resident educator license. The instruction shall 16  
cover such topics as student development and learning, pupil 17  
assessment procedures, curriculum development, classroom 18  
management, and teaching methodology. 19

(C) The rules adopted under this section shall require 20  
 applicants for the alternative resident educator license to 21  
 satisfy the following conditions prior to issuance of the license, 22  
 but they shall not require applicants to have completed a major or 23  
 coursework in the subject area for which application is being 24  
 made: 25

(1) Hold a minimum of a baccalaureate degree; 26

(2) Successfully complete the pedagogical training institute 27  
 described in division (B) of this section or a ~~summer~~ the 28  
preservice training ~~institute~~ provided to participants of a 29  
 teacher preparation program that ~~is operated by a nonprofit~~ 30  
~~organization and~~ has been approved by the chancellor. The 31  
 chancellor shall approve any such program that requires 32  
 participants to hold a bachelor's degree; have a cumulative 33  
 undergraduate grade point average of at least 2.5 out of 4.0, or 34  
 its equivalent; and successfully complete the program's ~~summer~~ 35  
teacher training ~~institute~~. 36

(3) Pass an examination in the subject area for which 37  
 application is being made. 38

(D) An alternative resident educator license shall be valid 39  
 for four years and shall be renewable for reasons specified by 40  
 rules adopted by the state board pursuant to division (A) of this 41  
 section. The state board, on a case-by-case basis, may extend the 42  
 license's duration as necessary to enable the license holder to 43  
 complete the Ohio teacher residency program established under 44  
 section 3319.223 of the Revised Code. 45

(E) The rules shall require the holder of an alternative 46  
 resident educator license, as a condition of continuing to hold 47  
 the license, to do all of the following: 48

(1) Participate in the Ohio teacher residency program;	49
(2) Show satisfactory progress in taking and successfully completing one of the following:	50
(a) At least twelve additional semester hours, or the equivalent, of college coursework in the principles and practices of teaching in such topics as student development and learning, pupil assessment procedures, curriculum development, classroom management, and teaching methodology;	51
