"Section 3. That Section 503.20 of Am. Sub. H.B. 49 of the 132nd General Assembly be amended to read as follows: 5

Sec. 503.20. SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENTS AND SETTLEMENTS 7
AGAINST THE STATE 8

Except as otherwise provided in this section, an 9
appropriation in this act or any other act may be used for the 10
purpose of satisfying judgments, settlements, or administrative 11
awards ordered or approved by the Court of Claims or by any 12
other court of competent jurisdiction in connection with civil 13
actions against the state. This authorization does not apply to 14
appropriations to be applied to or used for payment of 15
guarantees by or on behalf of the state, or for payments under 16



lease agreements relating to, or debt service on, bonds, notes, 17
or other obligations of the state. This authorization does not 18
apply to appropriations from the Oil and Gas Well Fund (Fund 19
5180) created in section 1509.02 of the Revised Code. 20

Notwithstanding any other statute to the contrary, this 21
authorization includes appropriations from funds into which 22
proceeds of direct obligations of the state are deposited only 23
to the extent that the judgment, settlement, or administrative 24
award is for, or represents, capital costs for which the 25
appropriation may otherwise be used and is consistent with the 26
purpose for which any related obligations were issued or entered 27
into. Nothing contained in this section is intended to subject 28
the state to suit in any forum in which it is not otherwise 29
subject to suit, and is not intended to waive or compromise any 30
defense or right available to the state in any suit against it. 31

Section 4. That existing Section 503.20 of Am. Sub. H.B. 32
49 of the 132nd General Assembly is hereby repealed." 33
