SCHOOL SAFETY TRAINING GRANTS 16

(A) The foregoing appropriation item 055502, School Safety Training Grants, shall be used by the Attorney General solely to make grants to both public and chartered nonpublic schools for school safety programs and training.

(B) The use of the grants includes, but is not limited to, all of the following:

(1) The support of school resource officer certification training;

(2) Any type of active shooter and school safety training;

(3) All grade level type educational resources;

(4) Training to identify and assist students with mental health issues;

(5) Any other training related to school safety.

(C) The schools shall work or contract with the county sheriff's office or a local police department in whose jurisdiction they are located to develop the programs and training described in divisions (B)(1), (2), (3), and (5) of this section.

Section 3. Within the limits set forth in this act, the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures from appropriations contained in this act shall be accounted for as though made in Am. Sub. H.B. 49 of the 132nd General Assembly.

The appropriations made in this act are subject to all provisions of Am. Sub. H.B. 49 of the 132nd General Assembly that are generally applicable to such appropriations."
