27 Modifies the conditions that, under a Medicaid waiver
28 component added by the House, an individual must satisfy to be
29 eligible for Medicaid as part of the expansion group (Group
30 VIII) by permitting veterans, new mothers, and specified
31 medically frail individuals to qualify for Medicaid under the
32 waiver component.
