Ohio College Opportunity Grant (OCOG) program 25

R.C. 3333.122, Repealed R.C. 3332.092, and Section 381.360 26

Disqualifies students who enroll for the first time in private, for-profit colleges from receiving the Ohio College Opportunity Grant (OCOG) after the bill's effective date but continues grant eligibility for students who are enrolled in such institutions prior to the bill's effective date.

Specifies that the earmarked portion of GRF appropriation item 235563, Ohio College Opportunity Grant, for students enrolled in private for-profit career colleges and schools be only used for such students that received awards in FY 2017. (The current version of the bill earmarks appropriation item 235563 as follows: (1) at least \$93,104,152 in FY 2018 and at least \$95,241,809 in FY 2019 for students enrolled in public and private nonprofit institutions of higher education and (2) the remainder for students enrolled in private for-profit career colleges and schools.)

11 disenrolled from an eligible institution at least 12 months
12 prior to receiving scholarship benefits under the program.
13 (Retains the other eligibility requirements for individuals in
14 the substitute bill, including that the individual: (1)
15 possesses student debt acquired while in pursuit of the
16 individual's first post-secondary credential, (2) disenrolled
17 from an eligible institution prior to obtaining the individual's
18 first post-secondary credential and desires to re-enroll to
19 obtain the individual's first post-secondary credential, and (3)
20 meets certain other requirements with respect to progress toward
21 the individual's first post-secondary credential.)
