A BILL

To enact section 2923.133 of the Revised Code to
prohibit the manufacture, sale, or transfer of
any trigger crank, bump-fire device, or other
product that accelerates a semi-automatic
firearm's rate of fire but does not convert it
into an automatic firearm.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 2923.133 of the Revised Code be
enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 2923.133. (A) No person shall manufacture, sell, or
transfer a trigger crank, a bump-fire device, or any part,
combination of parts, component, device, attachment, or
accessory that is designed or functions to accelerate the rate
of fire of a semi-automatic firearm but not convert the semi-
automatic firearm into an automatic firearm.

(B) Division (A) of this section does not apply with
respect to the manufacture for, sale to, or transfer to, the
United States or any department or agency of the United States
or this state, any other state, or a department, agency, or

political subdivision of this state or any other state. 19

(C) Whoever violates division (A) of this section is 20
guilty of "manufacture or transfer of a rate-of-fire 21
acceleration product," a felony of the second degree. 22
