Chairman Johnson called the Armed Services, Veterans Affairs, and Homeland Security Committee to order at 4:00 PM. After calling the committee to order Chairman Johnson welcomed members and led the committee in a prayer and Pledge.

The Chair then called House Bill 183 for its second hearing. There was no testimony submitted.
