Chairman Johnson asked the clerk to call the roll and HCR 21 was approved with a vote of 11-0.

The Chair then called House Bill 468 for its 2nd hearing and recognized Will Thompson to provide proponent testimony.

Chairman Johnson noted that there was also written testimony on the iPads.

With no further business, the committee adjourned at 4:23 PM.
