Dear Rep. Goodman:

I recently had the opportunity to read and review House Bill No. 295. This is a bill to exempt certain disabled veterans from paying a dog registration fee when application is made to the county auditor, that includes proof that the dog is an assistance dog.

As introduced: "(e) A person who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, including reserve components thereof, or of the national guard, who has been discharged or released from active duty in the armed forces under honorable conditions, and who has been diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, or any other service-related disability."

I believe that as a State, it is one very small thank you to honorably discharged, disabled veterans to be exempt from paying an annual dog registration fee for their trained assistance dog.
