3:02 p.m.: Chair Rep. Jim Butler called the meeting of the House Civil Justice Committee to order; roll was taken and a quorum was present. Chairman Butler said with a quorum present, the committee shall operate as a full committee. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved without objection.

3:03 p.m.: The Chair called House Bill 147 for its first hearing. The committee heard sponsor testimony from Rep. Hambley. Rep. Hambley responded to questions from Reps. Sykes, Celebrezze, and Lanese. Vice Chair Hughes moved to amend, and offered Am. 0241; Rep. Celebrezze objected to the amendment. Roll was taken; the vote was 9-4 in favor, and the amendment was added to the bill.

3:24 p.m.: The Chair called House Bill 174 for its first hearing. The committee heard sponsor testimony from Reps. Hughes & Lanese. The bill sponsors responded to questions from Reps. Celebrezze and Galonski.

3:27 p.m.: The Chair called House Bill 213 for its first hearing. The committee heard sponsor testimony from Rep. Dever. He responded to a questions from Rep. Sykes.
