



Committee Minutes

COMMITTEE: Economic Development, Commerce and Labor

Chairman Young called the Economic Development, Commerce and Labor Committee to order at 1:29 pm. The Clerk called the roll and a quorum was not present so the meeting began as a subcommittee.

Chairman Young called House Bill 245 for its first hearing. Ranking-Member Michele Lepore-Hagan provided sponsor testimony. Representative Kelly asked a question to which Lepore-Hagan replied.

The Chair then called HB 230 for its second hearing. Retired Sergeant Daniel Guthrie, Columbus Police Department, gave proponent testimony and answered a question asked by Chairman Young. That concluded the second hearing for HB 230.

At this point, a quorum was present and Chairman Young asked the committee to look over the minutes from the June 6th Committee Meeting. Hearing no objections or changes, the minutes were accepted.

Chairman Young called HB 127 for its second hearing, calling upon William Woodward, President of Iron Workers District Council of Southern Ohio and Vicinity to provide proponent testimony. Questions were asked by Reps. Sheehy, Kelly, Arndt, Reece, Landis, Greenspan, Lepore-Hagan and West. At 2:14, Vice-Chair DeVitis took over as Chair, until 2:17 pm.

Chairman Young called Representative John Boccieri to continue sponsor testimony on HB 245. He and Representative Lepore-Hagan then answered questions asked by Reps. Reece and Greenspan. This concluded the first hearing on HB 245.

The Chair then called HB 211 for its second hearing. Proponent testimony was given by Pete Kopf, President, Ohio Realtors. Questions were asked by Reps. Kelly and DeVitis, which Mr. Kopf and Chris Rees gave answers to. The Chair called forward Anjanette Frye, Treasurer of Ohio Realtors to give proponent testimony and answer questions from Reps. Reece, Young, Greenspan, and Arndt. Next, he called upon Tiffany Meyer, President-elect, Ohio Realtors, to give proponent testimony and answer a question from Rep. Lepore-Hagan. Next, Chris Reese, Treasurer-elect of Ohio Realtors, gave proponent testimony and answered a question asked by Rep. Arndt. This concluded the second hearing of HB 211.

Lastly, Chairman Young call HB 193 for its 3rd hearing. Dr. Sherman Alter, American Academy of Pediatrics, provided opponent testimony and answered questions asked by Reps. Lepore-Hagan, Young, Lipps, Sheehy, West, and Kelly. The Chair called the committees attention to written opponent testimony

provided by Dr. Steven Gordon of the Cleveland Clinic, Don Boyd of the Ohio Chamber of Commerce, and Rick Frank of the Ohio Hospital Association and Ohio State Medical Association.

Having concluded the business of the day, the House Economic Development, Commerce and Labor Committee was adjourned at 3:48 pm.
