



Committee Minutes

Chairman Young called the Economic Development, Commerce and Labor Committee to order at 1:35 pm. The Clerk called the roll and a quorum was present. Chairman Young asked the committee to review the minutes from the June 20th committee meeting. Without objection, the minutes were approved.

Chairman Young called House Bill 263 for its first hearing. Representative Lanese provided sponsor testimony. Representatives Kelly and Lapore-Hagan asked question to which Representative Lanese replied through the Chair.

The Chair then called HB 193 for its fourth hearing. All testimony provided was written-only and uploaded to the committee website and the Members iPads.

Chairman Young called upon Representative Greenspan for the purpose of a motion. Rep. Greenspan moved to amend HB 193 with Amendment AM0446X1. The amendment was in order and the Chairman asked the sponsor to explain the amendment. A question was asked by Rep. Brinkman and the sponsor, Rep. C. Hagan, responded to the questions through the Chair. An additional question of the sponsor was asked by Rep. Hood and was answered. A vote was taken and the amendment passed and became part of the bill with an 11-3 favorable consideration.

Chairman Young yielded to Representative West for the purpose of a motion to amend HB 193 with AM0520. The amendment was in order and the sponsor explained the amendment. Questions were asked by Rep. Brinkman and answered by the Sponsor. A vote was taken and the amendment passed and became part of the bill with 11-3 favorable consideration.

Chairman Young asked if there was any further discussion on the bill. Two amendments were offered by Ranking Member Lepore-Hagan; AM0523 and AM0505 and one amendment was offered by Rep. Sheehy; AM0515. These three amendments were ruled out of order by the Chair pursuant to House Rule 42.

Chairman Young asked what was the pleasure of the committee. Vice-Chairman DeVitis recommended that Amended House Bill 193 be passed by the committee and referred back to the Rules and Reference Committee. The Clerk called the roll and HB 193 was favorably passed with an 8-5 vote out of committee.

Chairman Young called HB 230 for its 3rd Hearing. Proponent testimony was provided by Dan Acton of the Ohio Real Estate Investor's Association. No questions were asked of the witness. Representative Kelly

moved to amend the bill with AM0524. A question was asked by Rep. Brinkman and answered by the Chairman. Vice-Chairman DeVitis moved to table the amendment. Representative Sheehy asked to speak on behalf of the amendment. After he spoke, Chairman Young asked for the role to be called regarding tabling the amendment. The amendment was tabled with an 8-4 vote. The amendment did not become part of the bill.

Having concluded the business of the day, the House Economic Development, Commerce and Labor Committee was adjourned at 2:20 pm.
