The Chair called HB 392 for its fifth hearing. Chairman Young asked to what was the favor of the committee. Rep. Hood moved to favorably report Amended HB 392 back to the Rules and Reference Committee. Chairman Young asked the clerk to take the roll. With a vote of 13 Yeas and 2 Nays, HB 392 passed. The Chair asked that LSC harmonize the amendments into a substitute bill prior to submitting it to the clerks office.

Seeing no further business to come before the committee and having concluded the business of the day, the House Economic Development, Commerce and Labor Committee was adjourned at 1:59 PM.
