Vice-Chairman Riedel called the Economic Development, Commerce and Labor Committee to order at 1:33 pm. The Clerk called the roll and a quorum was present. Recognizing a quorum present Chairman Young asked the committee to review the minutes from the February 27th committee meeting. Without objection, the minutes were approved.

Chairman Young called HCR 24 for its first hearing. Vice Chairman Riedel and Representative Holmes presented sponsor testimony. Representative Sheehy asked questions of the Sponsors of the bill. Seeing no further questions, that concluded the first hearing on HCR 24.

Chairman Young called HB 164 for its fourth hearing. The Chair called Dan Moore, executive Vice President of ABLE Roof to provide Opponent testimony on the bill. Questions were asked by Representatives Kelly, West, Stein, Young, Sheehy and Lipps. Chairman Young then called on Andrew Martinez, Member Director for the Ohio Hispanic Chamber of Commerce to provide opponent testimony. Representative West asked a series of questions. Chairman Young called upon Fred Horner, President of the Ohio Roofing Contractors Association to provide proponent testimony. Several questions were asked by Representatives Kelly, West, Lipps, Hood and Young. Finally, Chairman Young called upon Valerie Pope, deputy director of the Ohio Roofing Contractors Association to provide proponent testimony. Representative Hood asked several questions. Seeing no further questions, that concluded the fourth hearing on HB 164.

The Chair called HB 433 for its third hearing. The Chair called Ms. Corey Roscoe, Ohio State Director for the US Humane Society to provide proponent testimony. Rep. Kelly asked a question. The Chair then called Jack Advent, Executive Director of the Ohio Veterinary Medical Association to provide interested party testimony. Representatives Kelly and Sheehy asked questions of the witness. Chairman Young noted that there was written testimony on the members iPads from Ms. Beth Sheehen. Seeing no further questions, that concluded the third hearing on HB 433.

As the last order of business, Chairman Young called HB 504 for its second hearing for proponent testimony. The chair called Rebekah Matheny, assistant professor of interior design at The Ohio State University to the lectern to provide testimony. Representatives Kelly, Young
