



House Criminal Justice Committee

Chair Manning called the meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting to order at 1:35pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called Am. Senate Bill 7 for its 1st hearing. Senators Manning and Bacon were present and gave sponsor testimony. There were questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called House Bill 117 for its 1st hearing. Representatives Huffman and Brenner were present and gave sponsor testimony. There were questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called House Bill 109 for its 1st hearing. Representative Patmon was present and gave sponsor testimony. There were no questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called House Bill 97 for its 1st hearing. Representatives Boggs and Johnson were present and gave sponsor testimony. There were questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called Sub Senate Bill 25 for its 3rd hearing. The chairman inquired the pleasure of the committee, Rep. Rezabek moved the bill be favorably reported and to recommend its passage. The committee voted in favor of the bill, 11-0.

The Chair called House Bill 68 for its second hearing. Sub-Bill 0252-1 was proposed by Rep. Rezabek and accepted by the committee without objection. Executive Director John Murphy and Detectives Cottom and Bazilius testified before the committee. There were questions asked by the committee members.
