



House Criminal Justice Committee

Chair Manning called the meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting to order at 1:32pm. A quorum was present.

The Chair called House Bill 125 for its 1st hearing. Representatives Craig and Seitz were present and gave sponsor testimony. There were questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called Amended Senate Bill 7 for its 2nd hearing. Phyllis Carlson-Riehm, Nancy Neylon, and Anne Murray provided sponsor testimony. There were questions asked by the committee members. The committee also noted written testimony from John Murphy and a supplemental document from the Ohio Supreme Court's Advisory Committee on Domestic Violence.

The Chair called House Bill 96 for its 2nd hearing. Christie West, Becky Perkins and Nancy Neylon provided proponent testimony. There were no questions asked by the committee members. Members also noted written testimony from Mike DeWine and Lara Baker Morrish.

The Chair called House Bill 117 for its 2nd hearing. Committee heard testimony from J. Allen Chapman and Dina Cherney. There were no questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called House Bill 38 for its 3rd hearing. The chairman inquired the pleasure of the committee, Rep. Rezabek offered a substitute version of the bill, 0286-6. There were no questions regarding the sub-bill and no objections.
