



House Criminal Justice Committee
Representative Manning, Chair

Chair Manning called the meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting to order at 1:32pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called Senate Bill 33 for its 1st hearing. Senator Eklund was present and gave sponsor testimony. There were no questions asked by the committee members.

The Chair called Sub House Bill 38 for its 5th hearing. Chair Manning inquired the pleasure of the committee, Rep. Rezabek moved the bill be favorably reported and to recommend its passage. The committee voted in favor of the bill, 11-0.

The Chair called Amended Senate Bill 7 for its 3rd hearing. The Chair recognized Vice-Chair Rezabek who motioned for a substitute version of the bill, 0219-2. There were no questions or objections, and the sub-bill was accepted. The committee heard testimony from Katie Cornelius- Blume and Alexandria Ruden. There were no questions asked by the committee. Chair Manning inquired the pleasure of the committee, Rep. Rezabek moved Sub Senate Bill 7 be favorably reported and to recommend its passage. The committee voted in favor of the bill, 11-0.

The Chair called House Bill 125 for its 3rd hearing. The chair recognized Rep. Seitz who moved to amend, AM0174. There were no questions and the amendment became part of the bill.

The Chair called Sub House Bill 56 for its 2nd hearing. The chair recognized Vice-Chair Rezabek who moved to amend, AM0260. There were no questions and the amendment became part of the bill. The committee noted written testimony from Dr. Celia Williamson.

The Chair called House Bill 68 for its 3rd hearing. The Chair recognized Rep. Seitz who motioned for a substitute version of the bill, 0252-3. There were no questions or objections, and the sub-bill was accepted.

With no further business, the committee adjourned at 2:09pm.
