



House Criminal Justice Committee

Chair Manning called the meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting to order at 1:35pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called Senate Bill 1 for its 2<sup>nd</sup> hearing. Daniel Lutz, Scotty Mays, Travis Bornstein, Brenda Ryan, and Tugg Massa offered proponent testimony, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 137 for its 4th hearing. Committee members noted a letter of support from the Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio. The chair recognized Rep. Kent who motioned to favorably report the bill. The committee voted 13-0, the bill was reported out of committee and recommended for passage.

The Chair called House Bill 30 for its 3rd hearing. The Chair recognized Vice-Chair Rezabek who motioned to offer a substitute bill, 0184-9. There were no objections or questions about the sub-bill, and the committee began its consideration of it.

The Chair called Amended Senate Bill 33 for its 3rd hearing. The Chair recognized Vice-Chair Rezabek who proposed three amendments, AM 0472, AM 0643, and AM 0652. The committee had no questions or objections, and the amendments became part of the bill. No one was present to testify on the bill.

The Chair called House Bill 276 for its 2nd hearing. The committee heard testimony from Jason Dorsey, and noted written testimony from John Simpson, Joseph Phiel, Selwyn Dias, Linda Hinton, and a letter of support from the Coalition of Ohio Regional Districts, and a joint letter from Ohio Gas Association, Ohio Telephone Association, and Ohio Cable Telecommunications Association.

With no further business, the committee adjourned at 2:37pm.
