



House Criminal Justice Committee

Chair Manning called the meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting to order at 2:24pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. Chair Manning appointed Rep. Rogers as the secretary of the committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called Amended Senate Bill 33 for its 5th hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek offered a substitute bill, 0487-1, which was accepted. The Chair inquired the pleasure of the committee, Vice Chair Rezabek motioned to favorably report the bill and recommend its passage. The committee voted 11-0 in the affirmative.

The Chair called House Bill 354 for its 2nd hearing. Judge Steve Shuff offered proponent testimony, members asked questions, and the committee noted a supporting document.

The Chair called House Bill 141 for its 3rd hearing. Committee members heard testimony from John Clemons, committee members asked no questions, and noted written proponent testimony from Mike Dewine, opponent testimony from Niki Clum, and interested party testimony from the Paul Pfeifer.

The Chair called House Bill 283 for its 3rd hearing. No one was present to testify.

The Chair called House Bill 327 for its 3rd hearing. Gary Daniels testified as an opponent and questions were asked. Members noted written proponent testimony from Mike Dewine, and interested party testimony from the Paul Pfeifer.

With no further business, the committee adjourned at 3:16pm.
