



House Criminal Justice Committee

Chair Manning called the meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting to order at 1:34pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called House Bill 365 for its 3rd hearing. Gary Daniels from the ACLU of Ohio provided interested party testimony, Niki Clum from the Office of the Ohio Public Defender provided opponent testimony, and Sara Andrews from the Ohio Criminal Sentencing Commission provided interested party testimony. The committee asked questions and noted written proponent testimony from Phyllis Carlson-Riehm of ACTION Ohio.

The Chair called House Bill 283 from its 5th Hearing. The Chair inquired the pleasure of the committee, Vice-Chair Rezabek motioned to favorably report the bill and recommend its passage. The committee voted 11-0 in the affirmative.

The Chair called House Bill 354 for its 3rd Hearing. The Chair inquired the pleasure of the committee, Vice-Chair Rezabek motioned to favorably report the bill and recommend its passage. The committee voted 11-0 in the affirmative.
