



House Criminal Justice Committee

The meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting was called to order at 1:34pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called House Bill 96 for its 3rd hearing. Rep. Pelanda offered a sub bill, 0085-1, which was accepted without objection. The committee heard testimony from Niki Clum, and the committee asked questions. Members noted written testimony from Phyllis Carlson Riehm.

The Chair called House Bill 389 for its 1st hearing. Representative Antonio was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 423 for its 1st hearing. Representatives Seitz and Lang was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 365 for its 4th hearing. William Parker and Lisa Defendiefer gave testimony and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 405 for its 2nd hearing. Kevin Dye, Mike Weinman, Steven Haller, and Brandon Standley offered testimony and members asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 276 for its 3rd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek offered a sub-bill, 1158-5, which was accepted without objections. Members noted written letters of support from the American Municipal Electric Association, and the Ohio Municipal Electric Association.
