The meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting was called to order at 1:33pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called House Bill 439 for its 1st hearing. Representatives Dever and Ginter were present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called Amended House Bill 96 for its 4<sup>th</sup> Hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to favorably report the bill. The committee voted to report the bill to rules and reference and recommend its passage, 11-0.

The Chair called House Bill 276 for its 4<sup>th</sup> hearing. Lou Tobin testified and members asked questions. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to favorably report the bill. The committee voted to report the bill to rules and reference and recommend its passage, 12-0.

The Chair called House Bill 56 for its 4<sup>th</sup> hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek offered a substitute version for the bill, 0349-3. The committee accepted the substitute version without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 391 for its 2<sup>nd</sup> hearing. Judge Michael Goulding and Sharon Montgomery offered testimony and members asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 405 for its 3rd hearing. Lou Tobin gave testimony and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called Senate Bill 145 for its 2<sup>nd</sup> hearing. Jessica Koehler, Dr. Alicia Thompson, Josh Brown, and Dr. Anthony Joseph offered testimony and members asked questions. Members also noted written testimony.
