



House Criminal Justice Committee

The meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting was called to order at 1:39pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called House Bill 455 for its 1st hearing. Representative Wiggam was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 457 for its 1st hearing. Representative Antani was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 405 for its 3rd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to amend, AM 1143. The amendment was accepted without objection. Vice Chair Rezabek moved the committee favorably report the bill, and the committee voted to report the bill and recommend its passage, 12-0.

The Chair called House Bill 409 for its 2nd hearing. Judge Dennis Adkins provided proponent testimony, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 349 for its 2nd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to amend, AM 0294-1. The amendment was accepted without objection. Dr. Robert Davis, Allice Ault, and Janelle Hideg provided sponsor testimony, and the committee asked questions. Members noted written testimony from Jerry Whaley.

The Chair called House Bill 439 for its 3rd hearing. Sara Andrews, Patrick Plein, and Jason Pye gave proponent testimony, Niki Clum, Daniel Dew, and Gary Daniels provided interested party testimony and the committee asked questions. Members also noted written testimony from Judge Kenneth Spanagel.
