## Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_1238-2)
<b>Accidents involving law enforcement officers or public safety vehicles</b>	Amends the Vehicular Assault Law to prohibit negligently causing serious physical harm to a law enforcement officer while operating a motor vehicle (or other specified mode of transportation) and classifies the offense as vehicular assault.  Specifies that a violation of the prohibition is a first degree misdemeanor. (R.C. 2903.08.)	Instead, amends the "Move Over" Law to specify that if a driver negligently fails to move over when approaching a stationary public safety vehicle that is displaying flashing, oscillating, or rotating lights, and the failure results in serious physical harm to another or another's unborn, the driver is guilty of a first degree misdemeanor (R.C. 4511.213(D)(3)).
