The Chair called House Bill 528 for its 1st hearing. Representatives Rezabek and Smith were present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 296 for its 3rd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to amend, AM 1066. The amendment was accepted without objection. Gary Daniels testified in opposition and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 439 for its 3rd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek adopt a substitute version, 0645-9. The sub-bill was accepted without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 365 for its 5th hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek adopt a substitute version, 1563-2. The sub-bill was accepted without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 355 for its 2nd hearing. Claudette Ross, and Judge Tornichio provided proponent testimony and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called Senate Bill 145 for its 3rd hearing. Jessica Koehler provided proponent testimony and the committee asked questions. Dr. Wayne Trout and Gary Daniels offered opponent testimony and the committee asked questions.
