The meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting was called to order at 1:30pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called Senate Bill 66 for its 1st hearing. Senators Eklund and Tavares were present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 394 for its 2nd hearing. Judge Jan Long, Nikola Nable-Juris, Reggie Wilkinson, and Nicole Clum were present to testify, and the committee asked questions. Members also noted written testimony.

The Chair called Senate Bill 20 for its 2nd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek adopt a substitute version, 0184-12. The sub-bill was accepted without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 30 for its 4<sup>th</sup> hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek adopt a substitute version, 0184-9. The sub-bill was accepted without objection. Vice chair Rezabek moved to favorably report the bill, and the committee voted 11-1 to favorably report the legislation.

The Chair called House Bill 439 for its 3rd hearing. Lance Lemmonds, Lou Tobin, Judge Brian Hagan, Theodore Owens, Joe Savarise, Jeff Clayton, Rick Nagel, Charles Miller, Natasha Watts, Woody Fox, John Handler, Jonathon Smith, Tony Sylvester, Mary Frances Smith, and Erik Castle provided testimony and the committee asked questions.
