



House Criminal Justice Committee

The meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting was called to order at 1:30pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called Senate Bill 498 for its 1st hearing. Representative Schuring was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 553 for its 1st hearing. Representative Cupp was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called Senate Bill 66 for its 2nd hearing. Gary Mohr, Paul Pfeifer and Wendy Tarr provided testimony. Members also noted written testimony.

The Chair called House Bill 296 for its 4<sup>th</sup> hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek adopt a substitute version, 1377-1. The sub-bill was accepted without objection. Nicole Clum was present to testify and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called Sub Senate Bill 20 for its 3<sup>rd</sup> hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek adopt a substitute version, 1748. The sub-bill was accepted without objection. Louis Tobin and Nicole Clum were present to testify and the committee asked questions. Vice chair Rezabek moved to favorably report the bill, and the committee voted 11-0 to favorably report the legislation.

The Chair called Amended House Bill 355 for its 3rd hearing. Louis Tobin and Gary Daniels provided testimony and the committee asked questions.
