



House Criminal Justice Committee

The meeting of the House Criminal Justice Meeting was called to order at 1:30pm. A quorum was present.

With quorum now present, the committee operated as a full committee. The committee reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting, and there were no objections.

The Chair called House Bill 568 for its 1st hearing. Rep. Butler was present to testify, and the committee asked questions.

The Chair called House Bill 81 for its 4th hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to adopt a substitute version, 0191-4. The sub-bill was accepted without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 92 for its 4th hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to amend, AM 1911. The amendment was accepted without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 296 for its 5th hearing. Vice chair Rezabek moved to favorably report the bill, and the committee voted 12-1 to favorably report the legislation.

The Chair called House Bill 349 for its 4th hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to amend, AM 2130. The amendment was accepted without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 394 for its 3rd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to adopt a substitute version, 1279-3. The sub-bill was accepted without objection.

The Chair called Senate Bill 66 for its 3rd hearing. Vice Chair Rezabek moved to amend, AM 1921, 1933x2, 1956, 2087, 2088, 2132, and 1976 . The amendments were accepted without objection.
