



House Federalism and Interstate Relations Committee

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 85 for its second hearing.

Chairwoman Roegner moved to favorably report House Bill 85 as introduced. House Bill 85 passed with a vote of 6-2.

Chairwoman Roegner called Steven Weit and Sonal Vyas-Weit of Progress NW Ohio to provide opponent testimony for House Bill 228 and they were not present and the Chair submitted their testimonies as written testimony.

Chairwoman Roegner called Charles Reinhardt to provide proponent testimony for House Bill 228.

Candy Petticord of Buckeye Firearms Association provided proponent testimony for House Bill 228.

Written proponent testimony was provided by Dan Acton of the Ohio Real Estate Investors Association.
