



House Federalism and Interstate Relations Committee

Minutes: June 26, 2018

Chairwoman Roegner called the meeting to order at 2:05 PM. The roll was called and a quorum was present.

The minutes from the May 22, 2018 meeting were approved without objection.

Chairwoman Roegner called Sub Senate Bill 208 for its second hearing.

Chairwoman Roegner called Brian Steel of the Fraternal Order of Police Ohio to provide proponent testimony for Sub Senate Bill 208. Brian Steel provided proponent testimony and answered questions from the committee.

Written proponent testimonies were provided by Marc L. Terhar, Heinz Von Eckartsberg of the City of Dublin Police Department, and Major Theodore Owens of the Ohio Association of Security & Investigation Services.

Representative Leland introduced amendment 2381-1 for Sub Senate Bill 208 and there was discussion by the committee.

Vice Chair Becker motioned to table the amendment. Amendment 2381-1 was tabled by a vote of 7-3.

Vice Chair Becker moved to favorably report Sub Senate Bill 208. Sub Senate Bill 208 was favorably reported by a vote of 9-1.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Resolution 391 for its first hearing.

Chairwoman Roegner called Representative Ron Young to provide sponsor testimony for House Resolution 391. Representative Ron Young provided sponsor testimony.

Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 703 for its first hearing.

Vice Chair Becker moved to favorable report House Concurrent Resolution 26.

Chairwoman Roegner called Representative John Becker to provide sponsor testimony for House Bill 703. Representative John Becker provided sponsor testimony and answered questions from the committee.



Chairwoman Roegner called House Bill 580 for its third hearing.

Chairwoman Roegner called Erin Tuttle of the American Principles Project to provide interested party testimony for House Bill 580. Erin Tuttle provided interested party testimony and answered questions from the committee.

Micah Derry provided proponent testimony and answered questions from the committee.
