

## House Finance Committee

### Minutes

**March 6, 2018**

Chairman Smith called the meeting of the House Finance Committee to order at 10:12 am in Statehouse Room 313. Attendance was taken and a quorum was present.

Chairman Smith called up House Bill 529 for its third hearing.

Chairman Smith invited Greg Lawson, Statehouse Liaison and Policy Analyst at the Buckeye Institute, to offer interested party testimony on HB 529. Mr. Lawson answered questions of the committee.

Chairman Smith brought to attention written proponent testimony by William Murdock, Executive Director of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission; Dan Langshaw of the North Royalton City Council; and Sarah Spence, Director of Government Affairs for the Ohio Environmental Council Action Fund.

Representative Kelly moved to amend HB 529 (HC0006x1). Vice-Chair Ryan moved to table the amendment (HC0006x1). Ranking Member Cera objected. The motion to table passed 19-9.

Vice-Chairman Ryan moved to favorably report HB 529. The bill was favorably reported out by a vote of 28-0.

Chairman Smith called up House Bill 508 for its fourth hearing.

Vice-Chairman Ryan moved to amend HB 508 (AM1542). The motion was approved without objection.

Chairman Smith called up House Bill 378 for its seventh hearing.

Chairman Smith brought to attention written proponent testimony for HB 378 from Marcus W. Shelton, a Trustee of Harlan Township.

Representative Ryan moved to Amend HB 378 (AM1523). The motion was approved without objection.

Chairman Smith adjourned the committee at 10:43 am.
