


registration address was changed/updated in the DMV registration system on November 6, 2014(copy attached) ninety (90) days before the automated ticket was allegedly issued to the wrong address.

Per the above I contend that OnLinePayment.com made no legitimate effort whatsoever to comply with required notification processes related to the issuance of an automated speed ticket; further, OnLinePayment.com. has attempted to levy additional fines and penalties for non-payment based on the bogus first notification date and threatens to levy more fines, penalties and surcharges all of which I contest as any or all of those charges are linked to the misdirected non-issuance of the first violation notification.

I am appealing the issuance of a second/identical citation for what is essentially the same single event. I previously pled guilty to the officer's written ticket and to be charged a second time for the same offense constitutes double jeopardy. The police officer's ticket is vague in two aspects of the citation that I wish to question and contest. The police officer's stated clock time of the citation is 2:50 pm and the automated speed camera cites 2:51pm as its citation clock time. If these times are accurate and I challenge that they are, this means that traveling at 47 MPH as cited on the officer's ticket that I would have traveled 69 feet between both timers. I believe that that being ticketed twice within 69 feet is the same as charging me twice for the same and singular event thus constituting double jeopardy since I have pled to this infraction previously.
