Chairman Brinkman called the House Insurance Committee to order at 10:24 AM. A quorum was present.

Am. S.B. 169 was before the committee for sponsor testimony. Senator Steve Wilson provided sponsor testimony. No questions were asked.

Vice-Chair Henne made a motion to accept Sub. H.B. No. 156 (1_132_0895-1). Speaker Pro Temp Schuring explained the changes made in the sub-bill. No questions were asked. The sub-bill was adopted with no objections.

Sub. H.B. 336 was before the committee for proponent testimony.

- As joint sponsor of the bill, Representative Barnes spoke to the committee on the issues that his office and Rep. Greenspan's office are having with proponents being able to come and testify due to suspended licenses. This bill seeks to create a driver's license reinstatement fee amnesty initiative.
- Dr. Bonnie Robinson, Case Manager at the Lorain/Medina Community Based Correctional Facility, submitted written testimony for Sub. H.B. 336.

H.B. 380 was before the committee for sponsor testimony. Majority Floor Leader Bill Seitz and Representative Larry Householder provided sponsor testimony. The committee asked questions.

H.B. 268 was before the committee for proponent testimony.
