Referral Report

March 21, 2017

Representative Antonio reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills and Senate Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. B. No. 122 – Representatives Hambley, Rogers

To establish a Regional Economic Development Alliance Study Committee to study the benefits and challenges involved in creating regional economic development alliances.

To the committee on State and Local Government

H. B. No. 123 – Representatives Koehler, Ashford

To modify the Short-Term Loan Act, to specify a minimum duration requirement for loans made under the Small Loan Law and Mortgage Loan Law, and to limit the authority of credit services organizations to broker extensions of credit for buyers.

To the committee on Government Accountability and Oversight

H. B. No. 124 – Representatives Brenner, Carfagna

To authorize a joint vocational school district to submit the question of a renewal tax levy to voters who did not have an opportunity to vote on the levy at an election held in November of 2015 because the levy was only placed on the ballot in one of several counties in which the district has territory.

H. B. No. 125 – Representatives Craig, Seitz

To specify the jurisdiction of municipal and county courts over municipal traffic ordinances and to establish requirements governing fines, fees, or other charges for traffic violations and infractions imposed by a municipal corporation that does not have the authority to establish a mayor's court.

H. B. No. 126 – Representatives Boyd, Rezabek

To require a region-based kinship caregiver navigator program.

H. B. No. 127 – Representative Perales, Dever

To establish in the Ohio Building Code requirements pertaining to structural steel welding and bridge welding.

H. B. No. 128 – Representative Roegner

To permit a general contractor or owner of specified buildings to enter into a contract with a third-party private inspector or a certified building department for building inspection and to make other changes relating to building inspections.

To require the Governor to complete a forty-hour externship consisting of on-site work experience in city, local, and exempted village school districts in the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years.

To require the owner of an oil or gas well to provide a royalty statement to the holder of the royalty interest when the owner makes payment to the holder.
