Rules Report

The House Rules and Reference committee met on Tuesday, June 20, 2017, at 11:20 a.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, June 21, 2017

Sub. H. B. No. 170 Carfagna, Duffey, et al. – With regard to academic content standards and curriculum requirements for computer science; to revise educator qualifications regarding computer science; and to authorize public schools to establish computer science and technology funds.

Am. S. B. No. 2 Hite, et al. – To revise specified laws relating to environmental protection.

Sub. H. B. No. 213 Dever, et al. – To change the definition of "appraisal" for purposes of the Real Estate Appraiser Licensing Law, to make changes to certain procedures and the exceptions to licensure under that law, to regulate appraisal management companies, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 199 Blessing, et al. – To create the Ohio Residential Mortgage Lending Act for the purpose of regulating all non-depository lending secured by residential real estate and to limit the application of the current Mortgage Loan Law to unsecured loans and loans secured by other than residential real estate.

H. B. No. 158 Perales, Craig, et al. – To permit persons who quit work to accompany the person's spouse on a military transfer to be eligible for unemployment compensation benefits.

Sub. H. B. No. 95 Hughes, Seitz, et al. – To establish an enhanced penalty for committing a moving violation while distracted if the distraction is a contributing factor to the commission of the violation and to reenact provisions of law that specified that certain electronic wireless communications device violations were allied offenses of similar import.

H. B. No. 223 Dever – Relative to transfers of structured settlement payment rights.

H. B. No. 145 Huffman, Sprague, et al. – To provide for the establishment of a confidential program for the treatment of certain impaired practitioners and to declare an emergency.

Am. H. B. No. 69 Cupp, et al. – To require reimbursement of certain township fire and emergency medical service levy revenue forgone because of the creation of a municipal tax increment financing district.

H. B. No. 60 Hambley, Rogers, et al. – To authorize the issuance of an enhanced driver's license, enhanced commercial driver's license, and enhanced identification card to facilitate land and sea border crossings between the United States and Canada and Mexico, pursuant to an agreement with the United States Department of Homeland Security.

H. B. No. 10 Arndt, et al. – To permit intrastate equity crowdfunding under certain circumstances.

Sub. S. B. No. 7 Bacon, Manning, et al. – To provide the circumstances when service of a protection order or consent agreement upon a person is not necessary for the person to be convicted of the offense of violating a protection order.

Sub. H. B. No. 41 Pelanda, et al. – To modify the law concerning challenges to voter registrations, the appointment of observers, and the procedures for processing absent voter's ballots and for casting absent voter's ballots in person.

H. B. No. 125 Craig, Seitz, et al. – To specify the jurisdiction of municipal and county courts over municipal traffic ordinances and to establish requirements governing fines, fees, or other charges for traffic violations and infractions imposed by a municipal corporation that does not have the authority to establish a mayor's court.

Am. H. B. No. 195 Ingram, Seitz, et al. – To modify the provisions concerning the transport of persons who require the use of a wheelchair or other mobility aid in nonemergency circumstances.
