Introduction and Referral Report

Representative Celebrezze reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Concurrent Resolutions, House Resolutions, and Senate Concurrent Resolution be introduced and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. C. R. No. 13 – Representatives West, Thompson, et al.

To urge the Congress of the United States to pass the RECLAIM Act, which would assist communities negatively impacted by changes to the country's energy industry.

To the committee on Federalism and Interstate Relations

H. C. R. No. 14 – Representatives Lepore-Hagan, Leland, et al.

To affirm the commitment of the members of the General Assembly, in accordance with the aims of the Paris Agreement, to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to 26 to 28 per cent below 2005 levels by the year 2025.
