**Rules Report**

The House Rules and Reference committee met on Tuesday, October 31, 2017, at 11:00 a.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, November 1, 2017

**H. B. No. 214 LaTourette, Merrin, et al.** – To prohibit a person from performing, inducing, or attempting to perform or induce an abortion on a pregnant woman who is seeking the abortion because an unborn child has or may have Down Syndrome.

**Sub. H. B. No. 50 Schaffer, et al.** – To establish requirements for electronic benefit transfer cards issued under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program.

**Am. H. B. No. 174 Hughes, Lanese, et al.** – To add two judges to the Domestic Relations Division of the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, one to be elected in 2018 and one to be elected in 2020, and to declare an emergency.

**Sub. H. B. No. 119 Henne, McColley, et al.** – Regarding eligibility and benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance program and the Medicaid program.

**Am. H. B. No. 137 Kent, et al.** – To make peace officers mandatory reporters of child abuse or neglect and to expand the types of peace officers authorized to receive reports of child abuse and neglect.

**H. B. No. 292 Scherer, et al.** – To modify the test for determining an individual's state of residence for income tax purposes.

**H. B. No. 334 Scherer, et al.** – To provide that wages and guaranteed payments paid by a professional employer organization to the owner of a pass-through entity that has contracted with the organization may be considered business income.
