**Referral Report**

**November 28, 2017**

Representative Celebrezze reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Bills, House Joint Resolution, and Senate Bills be considered for the second time and referred to the following committees for consideration:

**H. B. No. 398 – Representatives Perales, Boggs**

To revise the law governing sales of spirituous liquor by micro-distilleries.

**To the committee on Government Accountability and Oversight**

**H. B. No. 399 – Representatives Henne, Butler**

To enact the Ohio Right to Shop Act to require health insurers to establish shared savings incentive programs for enrollees.

**To the committee on Health**

**H. B. No. 400 – Representative Holmes**

To designate the bridge spanning Squaw Creek, that is part of State Route 169 in Trumbull County, as the “World War I and World War II Veterans Memorial Bridge.”

**To the committee on Transportation and Public Safety**

**H. B. No. 401 – Representative Holmes**

To designate the bridge spanning Squaw Creek, that is part of United States Route 422 in Girard, as the “Purple Heart Veterans Memorial Bridge.”

**H. B. No. 402 – Representative Hill**

To revise state regulation of telephone companies.

**To the committee on Public Utilities**

**H. B. No. 403 – Representatives Howse, Kelly**

To create the Gender Pay Disparity Task Force.

**H. B. No. 404 – Representative Patton**

To create the “West Technical High School Alumni” license plate.

**H. B. No. 405 – Representative Perales**

To create the offense of counterfeiting and to include counterfeiting within the definition of “corrupt activity” under the Corrupt Activities Law.

**To the committee on Criminal Justice**

**H. B. No. 406 – Representative Lanese**

To include forensic evaluation examiners and mental health evaluation providers as individuals whose residential and familial information is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Law, and whose addresses public offices, upon request, must redact from records available to the general public on the internet.

**H. B. No. 407 – Representatives Dever, Seitz**

To abolish the estate by dower.

**To the committee on Civil Justice**

**H. B. No. 408 – Representatives West, Boggs**

To create the Health Insurance Participation Week.

**To the committee on Health**

**H. B. No. 409 – Representatives Butler, Perales**

To permit courts to create veterans treatment courts and to allow courts to divert certain criminal defendants to participate in veterans treatment court.

**To the committee on Criminal Justice**

**H. B. No. 410 – Representatives Seitz, Butler**

To grant municipal and county courts original and exclusive jurisdiction over any civil action concerning a traffic law violation, to specify that the court require an advance deposit for the filing of specified civil actions by the local authority bringing the civil action, and to modify the reporting requirements and LGF withholding that apply to subdivisions that operate traffic law photo-monitoring devices.

**H. B. No. 411 – Representatives Seitz, Sykes**

To modify the state’s wrongful imprisonment law.

**To the committee on Government Accountability and Oversight**

**H. B. No. 412 – Representative Craig**

To authorize county recorders, at the request of certain persons, to redact discriminatory covenants from real property instruments displayed on the internet, or to record modifications of those instruments.

**H. B. No. 413 – Representative Scherer**

Regarding Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) annual cost-of-living adjustments granted to allowance and benefit recipients and PERS service credit for services as a nonteaching school employee of a county board of developmental disabilities.

**To the committee on Aging and Long Term Care**

**H. B. No. 414 – Representative Schaffer**

To designate July 16 as “National Atomic Veterans Day” in Ohio.

**To the committee on Armed Services, Veterans Affairs, and Homeland Security**

**H. B. No. 415 – Representatives Greenspan, Ryan**

To allocate one-half of any surplus revenue to a new Local Government Road Improvement Fund, from which money will be distributed directly to local governments to fund road improvements.

**To the committee on State and Local Government**

**H. B. No. 416 – Representative Huffman**

Regarding the provision of cost estimates for scheduled health care services and health care services requiring insurer preauthorization.

**To the committee on Insurance**

**H. B. No. 417 – Representative Anielski**

To create the “Padua Franciscan High School” license plate.

**To the committee on Transportation and Public Safety**

**H. B. No. 418 – Representative Ingram**

To require a public or chartered nonpublic school to transmit a student’s records within five business days when the student transfers to another school.

**To the committee on Education and Career Readiness**

**H. B. No. 419 – Representative Henne**

To modify the defense to the liability of a member of a police or fire department or emergency medical service of a political subdivision for the negligent operation of a motor vehicle in response to an emergency by requiring that the vehicle has its lights and sirens simultaneously activated.

**To the committee on Civil Justice**

**H. B. No. 420 – Representatives Sykes, Boyd**

To designate the month of November as Ohio Adoption Awareness Month.

**To the committee on Community and Family Advancement**

**H. B. No. 421 – Representatives Patterson, Becker**

To provide that when a certificate of title is issued for a motor vehicle, the owner may request that the certificate indicate that the motor vehicle is a replica vehicle.

**H. B. No. 422 – Representatives Ginter, Rogers**

To govern acquisitions of municipal water-works and sewage disposal system companies by certain larger nonmunicipal water-works or sewage disposal system companies.

**To the committee on Energy and Natural Resources**

**H. B. No. 423 – Representatives Lang, Seitz**

To create the crime of masked intimidation, a misdemeanor of the first degree.

**To the committee on Criminal Justice**

**H. B. No. 424 – Representative Wiggam**

To enact the “Substance Recovery and Workforce Improvement Act” regarding drug testing and eligibility for unemployment compensation benefits.

**To the committee on Government Accountability and Oversight**

**H. B. No. 425 – Representatives Antani, Craig**

To provide that specified portions of peace officers’ body-worn camera recordings and the infrastructure record of a public school are not public records for purposes of the Public Records Law.

**H. B. No. 426 – Representative Hagan**

To prohibit an employee of a school or institution of higher education who is not in a position of authority from engaging in sexual conduct with certain students.

**H. J. R. No. 5 – Representative Antani**

Proposing to amend Sections 1a, 1b, 1e, and 1g of Article II of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to modify the requirements for the initiative and referendum processes.

Relative to transfers of structured settlement payment rights.
