Introduction and Referral Report

December 4, 2017

Representative Celebrezze reported for the Rules and Reference committee recommending that the following House Concurrent Resolutions, House Resolutions, and Senate Concurrent Resolutions be introduced and referred to the following committees for consideration:

H. C. R. No. 18 – Representatives West, Ramos

To memorialize the President and Congress to continue to protect net neutrality and open internet access.

To the committee on Federalism and Interstate Relations

H. C. R. No. 19 – Representatives Leland, Greenspan

To denounce and oppose the totalitarian impulses, violent terrorism, xenophobic biases, and bigoted ideologies that are promoted by white nationalists and neo-Nazis, to urge law enforcement to recognize white nationalist and neo-Nazi groups as terrorist organizations, and to pursue the criminal elements of these domestic terrorist organizations in the same manner and with the same fervor used to protect the United States from other manifestations of terrorism.

To the committee on Government Accountability and Oversight

H. C. R. No. 20 – Representative Schaffer

To urge Congress to encourage the Administrator of the FMCSA to change the crash indicator BASIC regulation standards to consider only crashes in which the driver was at fault for the crash.
