Rules Report

The House Rules and Reference committee met on Tuesday, January 30, 2018, at 12:00 p.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, January 31, 2018

H. B. No. 430 Schaffer, et al. – To expand the scope of a sales and use tax exemption for certain kinds of property used in the production of oil and gas.

Sub. H. B. No. 281 Carfagna, et al. – To establish the residential broadband expansion program within the Development Services Agency to award matching grants for last mile broadband expansion in municipal corporations and townships and to make an appropriation.

Am. H. B. No. 341 Huffman, Cera, et al. – To include judges and magistrates as individuals whose residential and familial information is exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Law, and whose addresses public offices, upon request, must redact from records available to the general public on the internet.

Am. H. B. No. 462 Schuring, West – To require that a hospital and its affiliated health care facilities in certain counties follow specified procedures before permanently ceasing operations or closing, to terminate the provisions of this act on June 19, 2018, and to declare an emergency.

Sub. H. B. No. 276 Rezabek, Greenspan, et al. – To expand the offense of aggravated menacing to prohibit threatening a utility worker, cable operator worker, or broadband worker with intent to obstruct the operation of a utility.

H. B. No. 279 Hill, Speaker Rosenberger, et al. – To require the Ohio History Connection to designate John Glenn's childhood home as a state historic site.

Sub. H. B. No. 300 Barnes, et al. – To provide that any nondriver identification card that is issued to a resident of Ohio who is permanently or irreversibly disabled must be issued with a 15-year expiration date and to exempt such cardholders who are also unemployed from the identification card fees.

Sub. S. B. No. 70 Coley, et al. – To amend the child support laws.
