The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Wednesday, March 7, 2018

H. B. No. 529 Ryan – To make capital appropriations and changes to the law governing capital projects and to make reappropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 2020.

H. B. No. 345 Butler, et al. – To adopt the Solemn Covenant of the States to award prizes for curing diseases.

Am. H. B. No. 87 Roegner, et al. – Regarding public moneys returned to the state as a result of a finding for recovery issued pursuant to an audit of the enrollment records of a community school.

Sub. H. B. No. 453 Greenspan, et al. – To require that all rights to and interests in discoveries or inventions made by, or patents issued to, employees using charter county hospital facilities or funding are the property of that charter county hospital.

H. B. No. 366 Gavarone, et al. – To make changes to the laws governing child support.

Sub. H. B. No. 438 Hambley, Kick, et al. – To permit the addition of appointed members to educational service center boards, to permit a local school district to sever its territory from one educational service center and annex that territory to an adjacent service center under specified conditions, and to authorize educational service centers to establish local professional development committees.

H. B. No. 347 Kelly, Dever, et al. – To designate a portion of I-71 in Hamilton County as the "Sonny L. Kim Memorial Highway."
