**Rules Report**

The House Rules and Reference committee met on Wednesday, June 6, 2018, at 4:10 p.m.

The following matters, being properly before the committee and pursuant to House Rule 66, were scheduled for third consideration on the House calendar in the order indicated below for the date indicated below.

Thursday, June 7, 2018

**H. B. No. 407 Dever, Seitz, et al.** – To abolish the estate by dower.

**Sub. H. B. No. 297 Hagan, et al.** – To allow persons to establish a joint ownership with right of survivorship with respect to an all-purpose vehicle or off-highway motorcycle and to allow owners of a motor vehicle, all-purpose vehicle, off-highway motorcycle, watercraft, or outboard motor who have joint ownership with right of survivorship to transfer title through a transfer-on-death designation.

**Sub. H. B. No. 391 Merrin, et al.** – To include the cost of accounting or auditing done to determine the extent of economic loss as a type of economic loss for which restitution may be granted.

**H. B. No. 433 Kelly, Brinkman, et al.** – To allow a licensed veterinarian to receive up to two continuing education credits per biennium for performing free spaying and neutering services.

**H. B. No. 414 Schaffer, et al.** – To designate July 16 as "National Atomic Veterans Day" in Ohio.

**Sub. H. B. No. 464 Lipps, Antonio, et al.** – To provide for recognition of stroke centers and establishment of protocols for assessment, treatment, and transport to hospitals of stroke patients.

**Am. H. B. No. 491 Edwards, et al.** – To require the State Board of Education to issue a substitute license to specified pupil services personnel.

**H. B. No. 535 Gavarone, et al.** – To require certain reports regarding overdoses and naloxone, to include naltrexone within the Ohio Automated Rx Reporting System, and to name this act the "Opioid Data and Communication Expansion Act."

**H. B. No. 315 Arndt, et al.** – To designate October 6 as "S.M.A.R.T. Parent Day."



**H. B. No. 123 Koehler, Ashford** – To modify the Short-Term Loan Act, to specify a minimum duration requirement for loans made under the Small Loan Law and Mortgage Loan Law, and to limit the authority of credit services organizations to broker extensions of credit for buyers.

**Sub. H. B. No. 456 Sprague, et al.** – To prohibit a hospital from requiring a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse to work overtime as a condition of continued employment.

**H. B. No. 411 Seitz, Sykes, et al.** – To modify the state's wrongful imprisonment law.

**H. R. No. 298 Sprague, Hill, et al.** – To recognize the existence of two alfalfa products in light of the recent action of the Ingredient Definition Committee of the Association of American Feed Control Officials.

**S. B. No. 139 Skindell, Eklund, et al.** – To adopt the Uniform Electronic Legal Material Act.

**S. B. No. 163 Wilson, et al.** – To modify the qualifications regarding notes eligible for investment of county inactive moneys.

**S. C. R. No. 15 O'Brien, Wilson, et al.** – To designate 2018 as "Ohio's Year of the Trails."

**Am. Sub. S. B. No. 135 LaRose, et al.** – To make supplemental operating appropriations for the FY 2018-FY 2019 biennium and issue certificate of participation obligations to implement a voting machine and equipment acquisition program.
