The Chair called Senate Concurrent Resolution 15 for its third hearing. No testimony was provided.

The following actions were taken on SCR 15:

Representative Hambley recommended that SCR 15 be favorably reported out of committee. Representative O'Brien seconded the motion. SCR 15 passed 12-0.

The Chair called House Bill 454 for its third hearing. No testimony was provided.

The following actions were taken on HB 454:

Representative Arndt recommended that L_132_1580-2 be adopted as Substitute House Bill 454. The motion was agreed to without objection.

The Chair called House Bill 146 for its seventh hearing. No testimony was provided.

The Chair called House Resolution 299 for its second hearing. No testimony was provided.
