

House Transportation and Public Safety Committee

Minutes

May 17, 2017

Chairman Green called the meeting of the House Transportation and Public Safety Committee to order with prayer at 9:00 am in Statehouse Room 017. Attendance was taken and a quorum was not present. The committee proceeded as a subcommittee.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 194 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Reps. Terry Johnson & Hearcel Craig to provide sponsor testimony of House Bill 194.

A quorum was achieved. The committee proceeded as a full committee. The minutes from April 26, 2017 were approved without objection.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 60 for its fourth hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Gary Daniels of ACLU of Ohio to provide opponent testimony of House Bill 60. Mr. Daniels answered the questions of the committee.
- Vice Chairman Greenspan moved to favorably report House Bill 60. The bill was favorably reported by a vote of 9-1. At the Chair's discretion the roll was left open in the clerk's office until 10:00 am the next day.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 95 for its fourth hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Ranking Member Sheehy who moved to amend HB 95 with AM 257x1. Ranking Member Sheehy explained the amendment.
- Chairman Green recognized Rep. Hughes to speak on the amendment.
- Vice Chairman Greenspan moved to table AM 257x1. The amendment was laid upon the table by a vote of 8-2 and failed to become a part of the bill.
- Chairman Green noted that Charles Burhan of Liberty Mutual Insurance submitted written proponent testimony for HB 95.
- Vice Chairman Greenspan moved to favorably report House Bill 95. The bill was favorably reported by a vote of 10-0. At the Chair's discretion the roll was left open in the clerk's office until 10:00 am the next day.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 150 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Rep. Bill Patmon to provide sponsor testimony of House Bill 150. Rep. Patmon answered the questions of the committee.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 159 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Rep. Craig Riedel to provide sponsor testimony of House Bill 159. Rep. Riedel answered the questions of the committee.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 188 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Rep. Mike Henne to provide sponsor testimony of House Bill 188. Rep. Henne answered the questions of the committee.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 194 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Reps. Bill Seitz & Catherine Ingram to provide sponsor testimony of House Bill 195. Reps. Seitz & Ingram answered the questions of the committee.
