

## House Transportation and Public Safety Committee

### Minutes

June 7, 2017

Chairman Green called the meeting of the House Transportation and Public Safety Committee to order with prayer at 9:00 am in Statehouse Room 017. Attendance was taken and a quorum was present. The minutes from May 24, 2017 were approved without objection.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 227 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green recognized Rep. LaTourette to provide sponsor testimony of House Bill 227. Rep. LaTourette answered the questions of the committee.
- Chairman Green recognized Ms. Katy McGrath to provide proponent testimony of House Bill 227. Ms. McGrath answered the questions of the committee.
- Representative Patton moved to amend House Bill 227 with AM 0340. The amendment was explained. LSC answered questions about the amendment. The motion was approved without objection and AM 0340 became a part of the bill.
- Representative moved to report favorably House Bill 227. The bill was reported favorably by a vote of 11-0. At the Chair's discretion, the roll was left open in the clerk's office until 10:00 am the next day.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 71 for its second hearing.
