Minutes

March 7, 2018

Chairman Green called the meeting of the House Transportation and Public Safety Committee to order with prayer at 10:18 am in Statehouse Room 017. Attendance was taken and a quorum was present. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved without objection.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 357 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green called Reps. Miller and Boggs for sponsor testimony of HB 357.
- Rep. Patton moved to favorably report House Bill 357. The bill was favorably reported by a vote of 12-0.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 521 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green called Rep. Boggs for sponsor testimony of HB 521.
- Rep. Patton moved to favorably report House Bill 521. The bill was favorably reported by a vote of 11-0.

Chairman Green called up Senate Bill 170 for its second hearing.

- Representative Patton moved to amend Senate Bill 170 with AM 1544x2. The amendment was explained. LSC answered questions about the amendment.

At 10:46 am Chairman Green put the committee at ease.

At 10:57 am Chairman Green called the committee back to order.

- Rep. Sheehy moved to table the amendment. With a vote of 7-6 motion was agreed to and AM 1544x2 was laid upon the table.
- Rep. Patton moved to favorably report Senate Bill 170. The bill was favorably reported by a vote of 13-0.

Chairman Green called up House Bill 475 for its first hearing.

- Chairman Green called Rep. West to give House Bill 475 sponsor testimony.
