

## House Finance Subcommittee on Transportation

### Minutes

February 8, 2017

Chairman McColley called the meeting of the House Finance Subcommittee on Transportation to order at 1:40pm in Statehouse room 313. Attendance was taken and a quorum was present. The minutes from the February 7, 2017 committee meeting were approved without objection.

Chairman McColley called up House Bill 26 for its second hearing before the subcommittee.

Chairman McColley called up John Born, the Director of the Department of Public Safety.
