Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_0653-2)
Voter eligibility	Authorizes an election on a multi-county joint vocational school district (JVSD) property tax renewal question that was improperly conducted at the 2015 general election by being submitted to only the electors of the most populous county in that territory, by allowing the JVSD to resubmit the question to only those electors who were denied the opportunity to vote on the issue in 2015, provided those electors were eligible to vote in that election <i>(Section 1(B).)</i>	Same, except authorizes all such electors residing outside the most populous county to vote on the resubmitted renewal levy, regardless of whether the elector was eligible to vote in the 2015 general election <i>(Section 1(B)).</i>
Tax resolution	Requires a JVSD to adopt a resolution resubmitting the renewal levy <i>(Section 1(B)).</i>	Same, but requires the resolution to state the same purpose, rate, and term as the original renewal levy considered at the 2015 general election <i>(Section</i>

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_0653-2)

Ballot language	Requires ballot language of the resubmitted renewal levy to be substantially identical to the ballot language for the original renewal levy on the 2015 general election ballot (<i>Section 1(B)</i>).	Same, but specifies that the ballot language must state the same purpose, rate, and term as the original renewal levy (<i>Section 1(B)</i>).
Emergency clause	No similar provision	Declares an emergency, making the bill effective immediately (<i>Section 2</i>).
