House Ways and Means Committee

March 14, 2018 – Minutes

Chairman Schaffer called the meeting of the House Ways and Means Committee to order at 10:02 AM on March 14, 2018. The roll was called and a quorum was present; minutes from the committee meeting held on March 13, 2018 were read and approved without objection.

Chairman Schaffer called Senate Bill 226 up for its fourth hearing. Written Testimony was provided by:

Vice Chair Scherer motioned to accept Amendment No. 1581. Retherford seconded the motion. Amendment No. 1581 was accepted without objection.

Representative Ramos motioned to accept Amendment No. 1627-1. Chairman Schaffer ruled the amendment out of order due to it being submitted late. Representative Ramos motioned to accept Amendment No. 1627. Representative Fedor seconded the motion. Vice Chair Scherer motioned to table Amendment No. 1627. Representative Green seconded the motion. Amendment No. 1627 was laid upon the table with 15 affirmative votes and 6 negative votes.

Representative Retherford motioned to favorably report Senate Bill 226. Representative Green seconded the motion. Senate Bill 226 was favorably reported with 20 affirmative votes and 1 negative vote.

The fourth hearing on Senate Bill 226 was concluded.

Chairman Schaffer requested LSC to harmonize the amendment into a sub-bill.

With no further business before the committee, the House Ways and Means Committee adjourned at 10:15 AM.
