Dear Senate Local Government, Public Safety, and Veterans Affairs Committee:

The Ohio Trucking Association represents over 800 trucking companies and allied vendor members. I am writing to you today to show you my support of authorizing the issuance of an enhanced driver's license, enhanced commercial driver's license, and enhanced identification card, which will facilitate land and sea border crossings between the United States, Canada, and Mexico, pursuant to an agreement with the United States Department of Homeland Security.

Every day, thousands of truck drivers cross the Canadian and Mexican borders during their workday. This transaction requires drivers to submit to the same documents as others, including a passport or passport card. This legislation would reduce the number of identifications required, which would streamline the process of crossing the border.

Currently, truck drivers are required to carry multiple identification cards to effectively perform their jobs, including: a Commercial Driver's License (CDL); a medical certification card; a passport or passport card; a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC); and a Free and Secure Trade credential (FAST). Additionally, drivers of hazardous materials are finger-printed and background checked. The industry has always complied with these regulations, but have always advocated for an approach that is not so cumbersome.
